


Endless Station Necklace Kit




Contents:

- 50cm black plated chain
- 55 x eye pins
- 10 x 5mm jump rings
- 10 x 6mm Swarovski clear globe beads in silk colour
- 15 x 6mm Swarovski bronze pearl beads
- 10 x 1.2cm jet faceted beads
- 10 x 0.9cm jet faceted beads
- 10 x 0.7cm jet faceted beads



Using the guide below, first pin all of the beads using EYE PINS.

Lay them out in groups according to the sizes and colours.




To prepare beads:

1. Insert the pin into the bead. Using flat nose pliers bend the pin to a 90 degree angle against the bead at the open end.
2. Trim the end of the pin to about 0.8 to 1cm length.
3. Use round nose pliers to loop the end of the pin, and close the loop.

Please have a look at our online video for more detailed instructions if you have not seen how to pin beads or open and close loops.

First make the beaded sections:

1. Once all the beads have been pinned and looped, connect a section of beads as this image. If you follow the sequence below, the result will be as the main image, but it is up to you if you prefer to change the bead order.



2. Make five of the above linked bead sections.
3. Next, cut the chain into five 10cm sections.
4. Using jump rings, connect one end of a bead section to the end of a chain section. Alternating bead and chain sections, connect each of the sections end to end using jump rings until you have one long continuous necklace. This can be worn as a long necklace or be folded over to make a shorter double row necklace.



Notes:

Difficulty level – easy/medium

Time to complete – 1.5 to 2 hours
