

Harmony, Stability, Safety Trio Necklace Kit



Contents:


- 1 green jasper briolette drop
- 12 Swarovski beads
- 1 irregular pearl
- 1.3m chain
- 15cm of 0.6mm wire
- 2 oval castings
- 3 clasps
- head pins
- jump rings



* Please note there are a few spare beads and jump rings included

Wire wrap the semi precious drop pendant bead:


1. Thread the 15cm wire through the top of the bead.
2. Pinch the wire together with your fingers over the tip of the bead, leaving a small triangle/gap.
3. Grab with your *flat nose* pliers just where the wires are pinched together.
4. Make a 90 degree bend with one side of the wire, then wrap it tightly around the first wire twice, and **cut the excess wire** as close as you can to the coil.



5. With the wire end that is left, make another loop with your *round nose pliers* about 1cm above the pendant.

Remove your round nose pliers, grab the loop gently with the *flat nose pliers* and coil the wire around over the previous coil, and then a few more times.

Trim excess wire carefully as close as you can to the coil, gently squeeze any sharp protruding wire with your *flat nose pliers*.




Single wire wrapped drop



6. Next, make the cluster for the bottom of the teardrop hoop. First make a skeleton of 3 jump rings connected in a row, and connect this to the link at the bottom of the teardrop hoop.

7. Pin and loop 5 beads and connect them onto the row of jump rings.



Connect 2 beads each to the top and middle links, and one bead to the bottom link.

8. Create a cluster for the flat oval link pendant. Connect a 5mm jump ring directly through the hole in the casting.

9. Pin and loop 4 beads and connect them directly to the single jump ring on the bottom of the pendant.



*Please have a look at our online video for more detailed instructions if you have not seen how to pin beads or open and close loops.

Prepare your chain:

- 10. Cut three lengths of chain:
14 inches / 35cm
16 inches / 40cm
18 inches / 46cm

- 11. Each chain needs to be finished with jump rings and clasps.

To one end connect 0.2cm and 0.5cm jump rings in alternating order.

Finish off the end with a bicone bead that has been pinned and looped.



To the other end of the chain, add a 0.2cm jump ring then a 0.5cm jump ring and clasp.

- 12. Finally, connect the pendants onto the chains using the 0.4mm heavy jump rings.

For this selection we have put the pendants on the chain lengths as shown, but this is up to you.



Notes:

Difficulty level – medium
Time to complete – 2 to 2.5 hours
