

Friendship Bracelets Kit




Contents:

- 3 x Liberty Tana Lawn fabric strips in 3 colourways. Each strip is 30cm long by 1.5cm wide
- 15 x gold jump rings & 7 x silver jump rings
- 35 x gold ball pins & 17 silver ball pins
- 55 x assorted beads
- 2 x gold charms & 1 x silver charm



Using the guide below, first pin all of the beads and charms you'd like to use.




To prepare beads:

1. Insert the ball pin into the bead. Using flat nose pliers bend the pin to a 90 degree angle against the bead at the open end.
2. Trim the end of the pin to about 0.8 to 1 cm length.
3. Use round nose pliers to loop the end of the pin, and close the loop.



To assemble the bracelet:

1. Make a row of 3 jump rings joined together. This makes the central skeleton of your cluster.



2. Attach an equal number of beads onto either side of the 3 jump rings. Approximately 4 beads per ring (2 on either side) will make a substantial sized cluster.




An example of a small cluster with only approximately 2 beads per jump ring.

3. Choose 2 extra beads and one charm. Attach individual jump rings onto these. These will go directly onto the fabric strip on either side of the cluster.



You can leave your cluster light like this one, or add beads to make it more substantial.

4. Thread the fabric strip through the jump rings, with the main cluster in the middle and the single beads and charm on either side. It is very important to make sure all your jump rings are completely closed so that your parts don't fall off.



5. Tie a knot on either side of the bead section to hold them in place.

To wear the bracelet, wrap around your wrist and tie a double knot or bow. This can be quite fiddly so you may need help with it.

Notes:

Difficulty level – medium

Time to complete – up to 1.5 hours
