


Hamsa Bracelet Kit



Contents:

- 1 x chain
- 1 x lobster clasp
- 1 x Swarovski hamsa charm in case
- Ball pins and jump rings
- Selection of crystal and montana blue beads
- Extender chain

Using the guide below, first pin all of the beads you'd like to use.



To prepare beads:

1. Insert the ball pin into the bead. Using flat nose pliers bend the pin to a 90 degree angle against the bead at the open end.
2. Trim the end of the pin to about 0.8 to 1 cm length.
3. Use round nose pliers to loop the end of the pin, and close the loop.

To assemble the bracelet:

1. Prepare your chain by connecting the clasp to one end using a jump ring.
2. Decide how long you would like the bracelet to be and cut the other end of the chain to the required length.
A standard bracelet length is about 17cm long.
3. Finish the other end of the chain with a jump ring OR add the extender chain (this is advisable if you are making this for someone else).
4. Assuming you would like the hamsa charm to be at the central point of the bracelet, fold the chain in half to find the centre, and connect the hamsa to the chain using a jump ring.
5. Finally, connect the remaining beads that you've already pinned directly onto the central chain, being careful to close them fully.
(Please have a look at our online video if you have not been shown how to open and close loops)
6. Consider how to lay out your beads – how would you like the colour to be spread?



There is an extender included in the kit, but you can also make your own extender by using 3 jump rings with small sections of chain in between.



Difficulty level – medium

Time to complete – 1-1.5 hours
