

Textured Double Drop Necklace Kit



Contents:

- 3 coil necklace memory wire (this should be enough to make 2 necklaces as you only need 1.25-1.5 coil per necklace)
- 16 mixed plating brass castings and rings (gold and silver, shiny and matt)
- 4 gold and silver solid cast metal beads
- 100 metal coated beads
- 20 mixed plating jump rings

* Please note there are a few spare beads included



1. Cut the coil so that it is long enough to fit around your neck once in a single loop.

2. Make a loop at one end of the coil by looping the end back on itself with round nose pliers. (This will also prevent the beads from sliding off when you thread them on).

3. Insert one of the large cast metal beads followed by the small metal coated beads until the coil is almost full.
Finish the end with another large metal bead, leaving about 2cm at the end to make a loop.

4. Make a final loop at the end to close the wire end so the beads cannot fall off.



5. Create two strands of metal castings by connecting them together with jump rings.

Make two strands, one longer than the other by one large casting or two small castings. The order in which to hang each part is up to you. Lay them out before connecting, and use the largest castings at the ends.

6. Finally, connect each strand to either end of the coil using jump rings.



Notes:

Difficulty level – easy

Time to complete – 1.5 to 2 hours
