

## Ombre Pearl Cluster Bracelet Kit

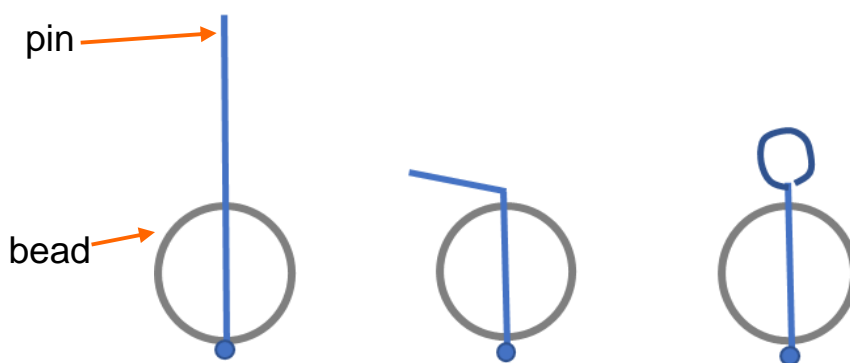


### Contents:

- 23cm curb chain
- 3 large jump rings
- 1 large circular clasp (so it is easy to open and close on ones own and looks like a feature)
- 24 x off white glass pearl
- 24 x platinum glass pearl
- 19 x hematite pearl
- 67 ball pins
- 68 jump rings



Using the guide below, first pin the beads, and lay them out in three groups according to the colours.



To prepare beads:

1. Insert the pin into the bead. Using flat nose pliers bend the pin to a 90 degree angle against the bead at the open end.
2. Trim the end of the pin to about 0.8 to 1cm length.
3. Use round nose pliers to loop the end of the pin, and close the loop.

Please have a look at our online video for more detailed instructions if you have not seen how to open and close loops.

To assemble the bracelet:

1. Cut the chain into an 18cm length for the main body. Using a jump ring, connect the clasp to one end of the chain.



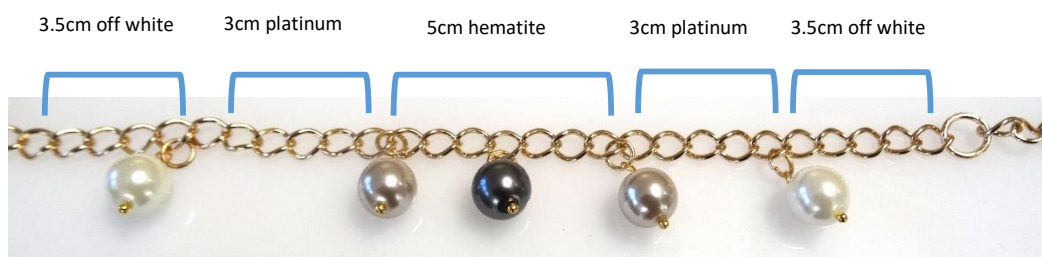
2. Cut another 5cm length to make your own extender chain.



Cut this 5cm length in two and join the two ends together again with a large jump ring in the middle to make extender chain. Connect the extender to the main bracelet chain with a jump ring. For a professional finish, also connect a hematite bead to the very end of the extender.



3. Before you attach the beads to the chain, measure out the colour sections first. The diagram below shows the lengths of each colour block section.



3.5cm off white – use 12 beads  
3cm platinum – use 12 beads  
5cm hematite – use 18 beads  
3cm platinum – use 12 beads  
3.5cm off white – use 12 beads



4. Connect each bead to the chain using a jump ring. Keep adding the beads to either side of the chain to build the cluster. You will need to attach more than one bead per chain link.

Notes:

Difficulty level – medium

Time to complete – 2 to 2.5 hours
