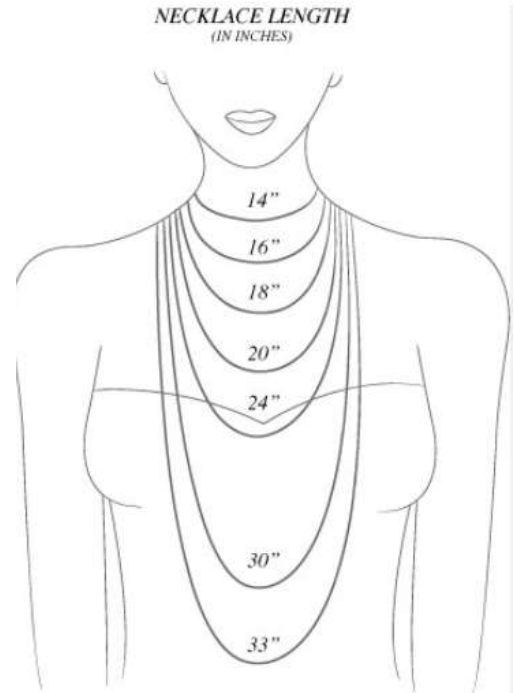


Guideline for Sizing Your Necklaces and Bracelets

A guideline for standard jewellery lengths, excluding an extender. Adding an extender gives the option of a longer length:

NECKLACE:		
Short necklace	16 – 18 inches	40 – 46cm
Long necklace	28 – 32 inches	71 – 81cm
BRACELET:		
thin chain / small beads	7 inches	17.5cm
chunky chain / large beads	7.5 inches	19cm



*Depending on the size of bead or chain used, the length of a bracelet will have to be adjusted. Large, wide chains or chunky beaded bracelets need to be longer, so please do measure against your own wrist before cutting the chain lengths.



Connect the clasp to one end of the chain using a jump ring.



Connect the extender chain to the other end of the main chain using a jump ring.



Make your own customised extender chain using short sections of chain and jump rings in between.
